Principal's Message

Dear Del Mar Families,

Progress Alerts, formally known as Progress Reports, will go out next week. If you receive a Progress Alert, it is important to take some time to sit down with your child and review the alert. The purpose of these alerts is to let both the student and family know that their teacher is concerned that they are not meeting expectations or making progress towards the standards (academic and/or Habits of Learning). At the bottom of the alert is a Family/Student/Teacher contract that we ask all families to complete with their child. These contracts provide communication to the teacher that the alert has been received and that we are all working together to make the progress needed before the end of the trimester. *What if my child did not receive a progress alert?* If your child did not receive a progress alert it means that the teacher has no concern with the amount of progress your child is making towards the academic and/or Habits of Learning standards.

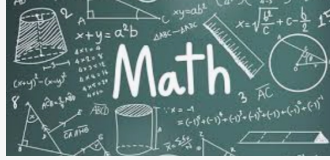

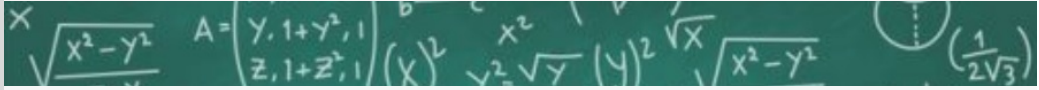
