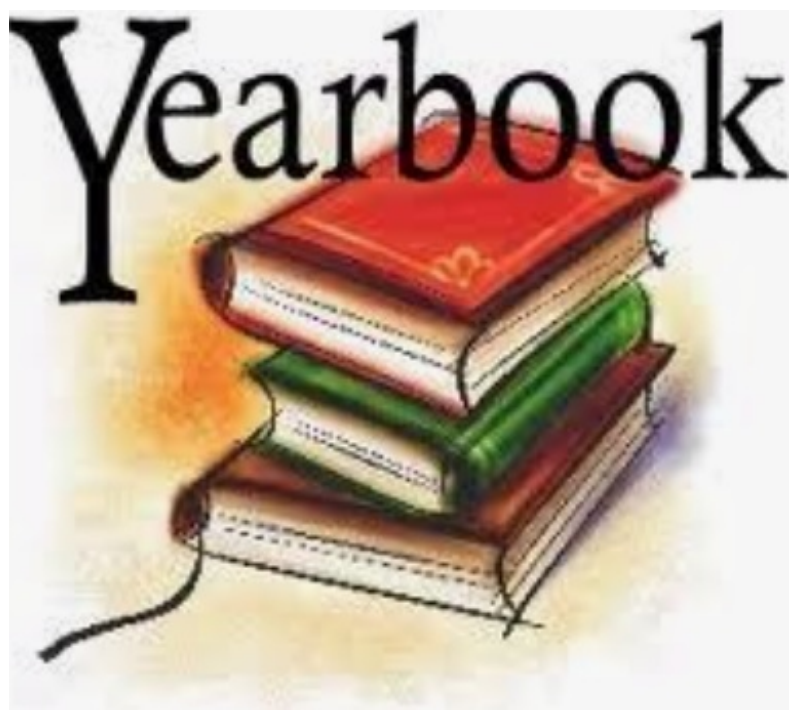


Basketball Jersey Return

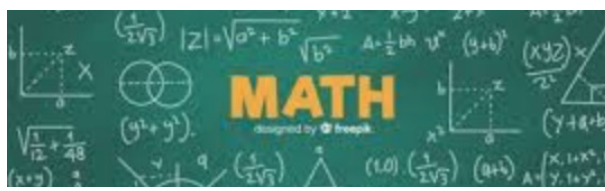
GRADUATION NEWS
