Dear Del Mar Families:

Special programs are underway to help students develop healthy and wise

decision-making skills in addition to promoting overall wellness. The Being Adept program provides all Del Mar students with 2-3 sessions related to tobacco, drug, and alcohol awareness and prevention. Seventh grade students will complete their units this month, the eighth grade course will begin in January, and the sixth grade program will begin in early February.

Seventh graders began working with Soul Shoppe to build self and social awareness and relationship skills. Students will learn how assumptions and judgments create disconnection, drama, and other hurtful behaviors. They will learn to build empathy for others, understanding how everyone has experienced some level of teasing, putdowns or other oppressive behaviors. Sixth and eighth grade students have separate assemblies planned for late winter, both reinforcing values and messages of empathy and respect.

We greatly appreciate the PTA support for funding some of the programming we are able to provide our students. All of these programs are part of our school and district-wide endeavors to reduce bullying and to promote kindness and inclusivity within and beyond our community. Please take time to discuss with your children how they are experiencing these programs.
