Student & Family Handbook for COVID-19 Health and Safety 2020-2021

DAILY CHECKLIST



Before coming to school, **check your child's temperature** and observe for [symptoms consistent with COVID-19](#) or any other contagious illness (e.g., cold, flu, strep throat, etc.). Do NOT send a child to school if they exhibit any symptoms.



Complete your **daily Actional health screening** for your child. You will receive a daily email from Actional asking you to complete a brief questionnaire for each child. Be sure to click the blue "submit" button when finished.



Be sure to adhere to your **staggered arrival and drop off times / locations** to help minimize mixing between student cohorts. Each school will designate a specific entry / exit area for your child.



Please be sure to arrive on time. Parents will need to stay in the car (or off campus) and students will need to go directly to their designated meeting location for a daily student health check with their teacher.



Cloth face coverings are required for all students at all times and must adhere to current [CDC Guidelines](#). If your child is unable to wear a face covering, you must provide written documentation from your healthcare provider to the school nurse.



Please be available, or **have several emergency contacts** available, to pick up your child within 30 minutes from school if they develop any symptoms of COVID-19 or other contagious illness.



Help your child understand that the school **nurse's office is only for urgent care** and medical emergencies. To limit non-essential exposure of students and staff, minor medical matters and first aid will be taken care of in the classroom.



Contact the school as soon as possible if your child is diagnosed with COVID-19 or has had close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19. You will be notified of procedures you must follow before your child returns to school.



And remember to **practice preventative measures at home** to keep your child, your household and our community healthy!
