A window will pop-up and you will tap the DreamBox icon a second time to launch it.○ From a computer:<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Visit https://launchpad.classlink.com/reed■ Click "Sign in with Google"■ Enter your district email and 10-digit password■ Once in Classlink, click on the DreamBox icon. <hr/> <p>Zearn (K-5) <i>Instruction-based learning for core math concepts</i></p>  <p>Zearn is an online version (with a printable companion) of the Eureka Math program that we use at Reed and Bel Aire.</p> <p>To access your account, follow these instructions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ From a computer or mobile device:<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Visit zearn.org■ Click "Sign in with Google"

- Enter your district email and 10-digit password
- Alternatively, you can access Zearn from the Classlink app (see directions in the DreamBox section above for setting up and using Classlink)
 - Open the Classlink app or visit Reed's [launchpad](#)
 - Click "Sign in with Google"
 - If needed, enter your district email and 10-digit password
 - Tap the Zearn icon
 - Click "Sign in with Google" again
 - Enjoy Zearn!
