Zearn is an online version (with a printable companion) of the Eureka Math program that we use at Reed and Bel Aire.

To access your account, follow these instructions:


- From a computer or mobile device:
 - Visit zearn.org
 - Click "Sign in with Google"
 - Enter your district email and 10-digit password (same as your AR login)
- Alternatively, you can access Zearn from the Classlink app (see directions in the DreamBox section above for setting up and using Classlink)
 - Open the Classlink app or visit the [launchpad](#)
 - Click "Sign in with Google"
 - If needed, enter your district email and 10-digit password (same as your AR login)
 - Tap the Zearn icon
 - Click "Sign in with Google" again
 - Enjoy Zearn!
