Some key actions implemented at each school site include:

Updated RUSD Handwashing & Sanitizing Protocols

Students are being instructed to wash/sanitize their hands:

- upon entering the classroom
- prior to eating
- before and after using an iPad (devices continue to be for one-to-one use, and are disinfected daily)

School Events & Closures

We are continuing to follow the CDC's guidance for communities without "active circulation" of the virus:

- there is no current recommendation to cancel school gatherings or field trips
- school closure would likely occur if there is a confirmed case in a staff member or student

Minimizing Potential Disease Spread

In addition to updating handwashing and sanitizing protocols, we are also reinforcing messages to:

- stay home when sick (persons with symptoms may not attend class, school events, or field trips)
- practice appropriate hygiene protocols (clean hands, avoid touching face, cover coughs/sneezes with tissues or elbow - not hands)
- regularly disinfect frequently touched objects


