S: Discuss **SAFETY TIPS** and **SUGGESTED ROUTES** with your student.

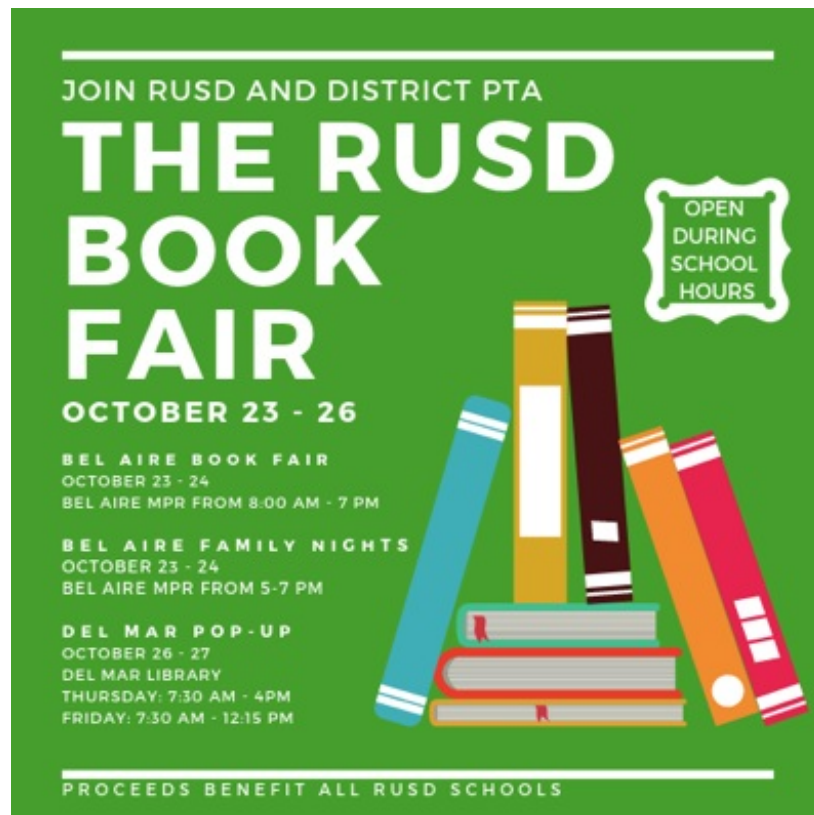
