Happy Friday! There are a few changes to public health guidelines that will be implemented Monday. Please take a little time this weekend to discuss your family's masking decision with your student. I also encourage you to discuss how important it is that we respect the decisions of others and treat one another with kindness and respect. Have a great weekend!

- **Indoor Masks Changing to “Strongly Recommended”** - Indoor mask guidance is changing from “mandated to strongly recommended” on Monday, March 14th for staff and students in schools. The CDC and the state have made the adjustment. Official guidance was released from the county public health department, so RUSD will follow.
- **Class Notifications of Active Cases** - If an active case is reported in your student's class, public health is asking that we start class notifications.
- **Stay Home with Symptoms** - It still remains important for everyone to stay home when experiencing symptoms.
