- Transitional Kindergarten (TK) If you have a student that is turning 5 years old between September 2nd and February 2nd, then he/she is eligible for TK. Enrollment is taking place April 12th. Informational Zoom meetings will be held on March 22nd.

Transitional Kindergarten (TK):

If you have a student that is turning 5 years old between September 2 - February 2, then he/she is eligible for Transitional Kindergarten which will eventually be Universal Pre-K (UPK) by 2025-26. TK Enrollment is taking place April 12th at Reed Elementary. If you would like more information about TK and UPK, there will be two informational Zoom meetings on March 22nd. The first one will be held from 10:30 AM to 11:30 AM and the second will be from 4:00 PM to 5:00 PM. Zoom links for the two meetings will be sent out on March 21st. Please help us spread the word to families in our community.

Buildier's Studio - Dr. Mary Niesyn, Principal at Reed School, three members of the Reed teaching team and six amazing students came to the board meeting to talk about the Reed Builder's Studio and show some of their creations. RUSD Superintendent Receives Her Doctorate- Dr. Kimberly McGrath, RUSD Superintendent, successfully defended her dissertation on the pros and cons of parcel taxes on February 18th, 2022. Congratulations are in order for **Dr.** McGrath on receiving her Doctorate in Organizational Leadership!

Superintendent Update - Dr. McGrath updated the board on multiple topics including the state mandated free meals for the 2022-23 school year, interdistrict transfers, COVID in our schools, kindergarten enrollment projections, the Tiburon library collaboration, and the newly formed math task force (starting March 16th).

Trustee Updates - Trustees reported out on their activities over the last month including their attendance at JLAC's legislative advocacy day via zoom, updates on the bus programming for 2022-23, The Ranch updates on spring enrichment and summer camps, and the Schools to Watch Leadership Celebration honoring Del Mar.

Master Facilities Planning (FMP) - At the February board meeting, the board approved Capitol PFG to lead our facilities master planning. CBO Carlos Estrella and Cathy Dominico from Capitol PFG presented information on the RUSD project planning, which will take approximately one year to complete and will kick-off on March 17th. Thank you to all who have volunteered.

OPEB Liabilities - Mr. Estrella and Luis Murillo, TCS consultant, presented to the board their work recommending best practices in creating a plan to fund the OPEB liabilities.


