COVID Test Kits being sent home with all students TODAY

RUSD Community,

We hope that you have an enjoyable holiday weekend. As you may know, Marin County has reported high cases of COVID-19 in our community. We care about the health and safety of your family and support your decisions for personal safety. Marin Public Health strongly recommends masking indoors while cases are high in the community, optimizing ventilation, testing on Day 5 after exposure to a positive person, and isolating if symptomatic with testing. RUSD strives to ensure students have access to what they need for a family's personal choice. Each of our school sites has masks and test kits available for our students. Our classrooms have improved ventilation and we strictly follow Marin Public Health's direction for the required time away from school for isolation and illness. We also notify any group who shared indoor airspace with an infected individual for 15 minutes or more so that your family can be informed in your selection of personal safety measures.

As an extension of our efforts, we are sending test kits home with students today, Friday, May 27th. If you feel that your child may have been exposed, traveled, or if your family spent time with crowds (especially indoors), choosing to test before returning to school will help to prevent exposure in our classrooms. Please remember that everyone must stay home from school if symptomatic, seek testing, and notify the school's attendance office of the absence. Thank you for your continued support as we work together in our efforts for the health and safety of our RUSD community.
