An Important Message from Superintendent, Dr. Nancy Lynch

Dear RUSD Community,

We are currently investigating allegations that a student in our Del Mar community made threats to a local business via Instagram yesterday. The statements expressed in the posts do not align with the mission and vision of the Reed Union School District and do not meet our expectations for how members of our school community should behave or communicate.

We take all threats seriously and are partnering with the Tiburon Police Department to ensure the safety of our students and our community. Please note the account has been deactivated, the posts removed, and we believe this was a fictitious account. We have no information to indicate any risks to the safety or well being of any RUSD students. At this point in our investigation, we know these posts on Instagram were not made on a district-issued device nor made during school hours. We will continue to work with the Tiburon Police Department in their investigation of this incident.
