**Student COVID-19 Vaccination Side Effects and Student Absences  
Reminder from our School Nurses**

Students receiving the COVID-19 vaccination may experience side effects within the first 1-2 days including injection site pain, redness or swelling, fever, headache, fatigue, body aches and chills. They usually only last 1-2 days. If your student's symptoms last longer than 2-3 days, or include a cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell, your student should quarantine at home and be tested for COVID-19 as soon as possible.

Remember that we have antigen tests available for your convenience. If your student is absent due to side effects or symptoms of illness, please remember to notify your school site attendance and provide all symptom details as well as whether or not your student received the vaccine recently.
