A Message from Superintendent, Dr. Nancy Lynch

Dear RUSD Families and Staff,

The safety of students and staff is our main priority. We want to inform you that we received confirmation today that two sixth-grade students at Del Mar have tested positive for COVID-19. The school and/or Public Health are contacting anyone who may have been in close contact with these students and would therefore need to quarantine. The classroom cohorts of these students have shifted to distance learning for the next 14 days.

In the spirit of transparency, it is important that we notify and reassure our community within the parameters of confidentiality of this situation. We will continue to inform all RUSD families and staff of any confirmed positive COVID-19 cases in the district. We would like to underscore the importance of wearing masks, maintaining social distancing, and staying home when experiencing COVID-like symptoms. The protocols we have put in place at school minimize the risk of exposure when everyone does their part.
