A Message from Superintendent, Dr. Nancy Lynch

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Important Message About After School Buses:

We have become aware that a number of students riding our school buses without passes as of late. This is not permissible for a number of reasons, including the safety of our riders, overcrowding on buses, and because it is unfair to the annual pass holders that have paid for their seats.

A simple solution for parents who wish for their children to ride buses from time to time without an annual pass (either to their own homes or to a playdate) is to purchase a single-use playdate pass, available [HERE](#). These passes are only available for routes that are not sold out.

You must abide by the following rules in order to use your playdate pass:

- When available, you may purchase a one-day, one-way "Playdate Pass." Playdate passes must be purchased at least 24 hours in advance.
- After purchasing a pass **you must email info@buschallenge.org** to indicate the name of the rider, and on which date the pass will be used. This allows us to track our inventory, be aware of who is riding on which bus every day, ensure there is space for your rider, and notify the school that your student is permitted to ride. **Your student will not be permitted to ride the bus without this prior approval.**
- **PRINT** a copy of your receipt *or* **SHOW** the receipt on your phone, and ask your child to show it to the driver when boarding.
- **DISCARD** that printed receipt after a single use.

For parents interested in an annual pass who have not yet purchased one, we are also selling **half price passes** on routes that are not yet sold out. Please email info@buschallenge.org if you would like to inquire about half price passes, or with any questions.

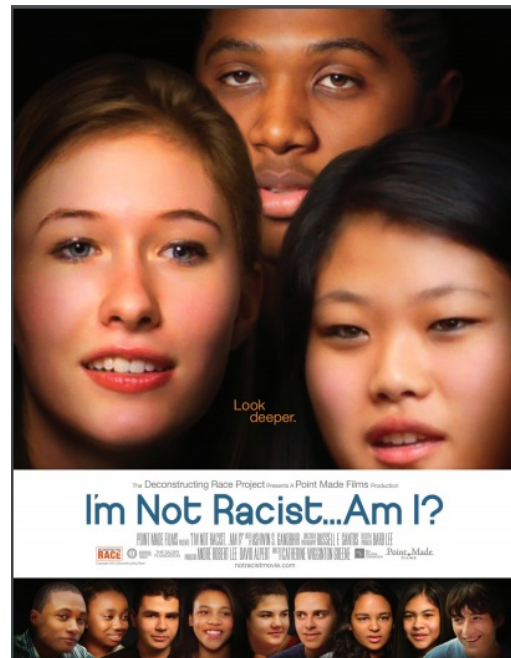
Please join us at the Mill Valley Community Center on Thursday, February 28th for a screening and discussion of the new documentary **I'm Not Racist... Am I?**
