Safe Routes to Schools: As students begin Phase 2 in-person learning, please consider green forms of transportation to reduce traffic congestion around Reed Elementary School. With no yellow school busses to any of the three Reed Union schools, traffic is

anticipated to increase significantly on Tiburon Boulevard. Biking from Blackie's Pasture (1.8 miles) takes approximately 15 minute or please consider parking ½ mile away (e.g., at the Town Hall parking lot) and walking (about a 10 minute walk). (Please note: there will be pavement work along Old Rail Trail between Mar West and San Rafael this Thursday. A detour will be in place through Lagoon Road with flaggers assisting pedestrians and crossovers. Visit the Town website for more details: <http://townoftiburon.org/260/Current-Projects>)
