School Safety

As parents, we have discussions from time to time about student safety while on the way to and from school. It is important to review procedures with your child on how to stay safe when they are on the way to or from school and also during non-school hours. Creating awareness for them to pay attention to their surroundings and what to do if an adult they do not know approaches them is important. In Reed Union School District, we continually strive to improve protocols and procedures to ensure student safety while at school. Students participate in fire, earthquake and intruder drills throughout the year to prepare for emergencies. Teachers have received training in how to respond to emergencies, and each school maintains a plan to address these situations if they arise.

We are beginning the process of updating our Comprehensive School Safety Plan that addresses the physical safety of our schools as well as programs that support student's social and emotional well-being. Parent input is important to ensure we have different perspectives when making recommendations to update and expand our plan. If you are
